The War Office has issued the following telegram from Lord Kitchener: 'Headquarters, Wednesday, July 15, 1901. Following letters found in my possession at Pretoria on Tuesday, July 15, 1901, to be sent to the Secretary of State, London, July 15, 1901.'

THE BOER CAPTURE A TRAIN

Lord Kitchener reported from Pretoria on Tuesday: 'On the 14th inst. a train of 1100 tons, containing 1000 tons of stores, was held up morning 11 miles north of Beaufort West by the Boers.'
